## Estate Settles With Veterans Administration, Doctor In Medmal Dispute Over Cancer Diagnosis

## \$600,000 Settlement

On March 27, 2001. Jessie Phillips was admitted to the William Jennings Bryan Dom VA Hospital where Dr. Einar Anderson ordered that he undergo a chest x-ray. The results of the x-ray revealed a 2-centimeter nodule on Mr. Phillips' left upper lobe. The radiologist recommended that additional tests be performed; however Dr. Anderson and the medical staff caring for Mr. Phillips did not conduct additional evaluations nor did they make any inquiries about the x-ray findings.

Approximately two and a half years later on Oct. 31, 2003 it was discovered that the lesion had grown. A biopsy was obtained and pathology findings were significant for carcinoma.

Mr. Phillips was diagnosed with lung cancer, which he eventually died from on Dec. 19.2003.
